New York's Medical Aid in Dying Act (A995a/S2445a) would allow a terminally ill, mentally capable adult to request a prescription for medication from their doctor that they can decide to take, at a time of their choosing, to bring about a peaceful death. *Medical Aid in Dying* will take place on Sunday, December 10, from 12:30 to 2 pm at the Yonkers Riverfront Library. Speakers include: One of the bill's sponsors in the State Assembly, Health Committee Chair Amy Paulin; an expert

on the bill; a medical doctor; and a religious leader. *An audience Q&A will follow the presentation.*

The League of Women Voters of New York State supports medical aid in dying. LWV Rivertowns recently held a program on this topic as well. RSVP at bit.ly/121023NYMAiD
